Management, human sciences, technology and engineering have all made huge advances in the last few decades that left the safety profession behind. In safety, we are still stuck in a psychology that is 30-40 years outdated, where many of our safety concepts are from the 1950's and earlier and are now obsolete, and yet we still run with them every day, faster and harder.

"Safety is on the Edge", balancing on a cliff's edge, and if we as safety professionals don't recognize this and become part of the change, we run the risk of being left behind. Safety in most organizations has plateaued, and even deteriorated despite our best efforts. We simply have to start doing safety differently, but what, how and why?
